BRITISH ELITE HORSE SHOW

RULES

Competitors of the British Elite Horse Show do not need to be affiliated or be members of any society except for those classes offering qualification. **Non members** can **compete** but are not eligible to qualify. All persons entering, competing or otherwise being present at the show, are subject to the constitution of the British Elite show including disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the British Elite committee. Owners entering animals do so entirely at their own risk, and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attached itself to the promoters or organisers in any respect whatsoever. Riders must be of the correct age for the height of the class. All ridden classes are confined to mares/geldings, 4 yrs old and over. Stallions and colts are permitted to compete in In-hand, and stallions are permitted to be ridden in Mountain and Moorland and coloured classes only providing the handler/rider is the correct age.

HATS THAT CONFORM TO BRITISH SAFETY STANDARDS MUST BE WORN WHEN MOUNTED (With the exception of classes 65, 66, 67, 68, 69, 83 & 84 providing a disclaimer form has been signed at the secretaries office prior to the class. This is done at your own risk).

NO EARRINGS ALLOWED

Clashing of classes - Whilst every effort has been taken to avoid clashing of classes, this may be unavoidable. The British Elite reserves the right to alter/amend the schedule as they see fit. No refunds of entries will be given if competitors are entered in classes that clash.

Animals must not have been on a professional producers/trainers yard since 1st March in the current year. Riders are not eligible to compete any animal which has been ridden or produced by a professional producer/trainer at any show since 1st March in the current year, but they are able to compete any other animal that has not been produced or ridden professionally since the 1st March in the current year.

The British Elite committee expects competitors to accept the rules of this competition in the spirit intended.

***Novice Ruling** - Regardless of the number of Novice or Open classes a FOUR and FIVE year* old animal may win, it retains its novice status at the commencement of its SIX year old year, except any animal that has been placed 1st to 5th at the RIHS or HOYS in any classes, it will immediately be de noviced. **Ponies SIX Years Old and Over.** A Pony SIX years old or over, that has won three Open or Restricted affiliated classes where the first prize is £5.00 or over, or has been placed 1st to 5th at the RIHS or the HOYS will immediately be classed as an Open and is no longer eligible for Novice Classes.

Rules for RIHS Qualifiers. This show is a qualifier for THE ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW. Only one pony in each of the Mixed Height Pretty Polly Open Show pony or Open Show Hunter Pony or Pretty Polly Heritage Mixed Breeds qualifiers. The highest placed (not already qualified) from the first three ponies placed in each class will qualify.
